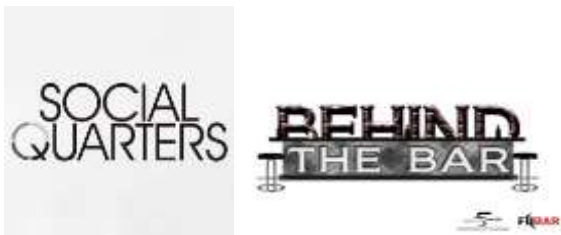
Do you.... “believe in Honoring our Veterans one final time”?
